



A Message From Cheri ...

Many thanks to all of you for your fantastic support for this event and to the other branches in the Southwest Region: Champaign, Dayton, Logan, Middletown, Mason and Sidney for their contributions and staffing assistance. Congratulations also to our new state President: Christine Siebeneck. She will be fun to work with. In this year of our voices: Advocacy and Action, AAUW has some PEARLS (Policy, Education, Advocacy, Research, Leadership, Social) to share.

Human Trafficking has again emerged as an AAUW priority and I'd like to have Sheriff Kelly back to do another program on this topic. Pay Equity and Voting Rights and the challenge of curbing further massive cuts in Ohio's public educational system are additional issues of interest. In case you were not aware, over \$800 million was cut from Public Education and that is why we have so many local school levies – the state cut their funds and they have to get it from the local communities. Issues such as Branch Board burn out and Marketing the Branch were also workshop topics. If you missed the Convention, then put August 9, 2014 for a Leadership Conference at Otterbein on your calendar. If you have not attended this, you should plan to attend this day-long training session.

PUBLIC POLICY: I have information on the Common Core issue, Voting Rights and Pay Equity that will be available at our May potluck. I know that many of you are not interested in politics, but with Voter Suppression taking effect in Ohio, Pay Equity and Public Education at risk more and more, I hope to engage you in speaking out on these issues. All of our gains since the 1960's are now in serious jeopardy.

From the April 2014 State AAUW Convention


